Guided Tours

We realise that the main purpose of your visit to Liverpool is for your conference or event. However, it would be a pity if your delegates left the city without having seen at least some of this former Capital of Culture.



Whether you have time allocated during your conference programme for leisure or if you feel delegates would like to take a guided coach or walking tour after the day's business is done, we can take on the arrangements for this.

We will book the Tour Guide and, if necessary, the coach and we can even handle the individual bookings, if this will help to take away from you the hassle associated with organising a guided tour.

Even if you want to make a guided tour available, but you need the delegates to pay individually, we can handle the individual payments too.

City Panoramic Tour

This is our most popular tour, giving the passenger an insight into the history of Liverpool, the story of how the City has developed over the years and it will also act a good signpost for places that the visitor may want to see in their own time.

The tour will enable the visitor to see the City's major landmarks, including Cathedrals, Town Hall, Pier Head, Albert Dock and the Museums and Galleries. The tour can also include an internal visit to one of the Cathedrals and a trip to Penny Lane.



The Beatles Tour



This is the definitive tour for Beatles' fans, young and old alike.

Accompanied throughout by music of the Fab Four, the tour takes you to one of each of their homes, schools and colleges where they studied, Penny Lane and Strawberry Field and arguably the most

important place in rock and roll history, where John and Paul met for the first time. This is a 'must do' tour for Beatles fans.

City Panoramic and Beatles Tour

It is difficult, often, to find the balance between a City Tour and a Beatles Tour. So why not do a combination! This suggested tour includes all of the major buildings of Liverpool together with the main Beatles sites. You can still see the homes of John and Paul together with Penny Lane and Strawberry Field.

Maritime and World Heritage Site

This walking tour will introduce you to the maritime history of Liverpool, taking in the Albert Dock, the UNESCO World Heritage site at the Pier Head and then heading into the business district to view the Town Hall, the location of Liverpool's castle and to take a look at some of Liverpool's original seven streets.



Ale Trail

There is no better way to enjoy the sights and history of Liverpool than by interspersing your tour with a drink or two at a local pub. The tour will centre on several of Liverpool's historic pubs, from spectacular Gin Places to maritime hostelries, all with stories to tell. Along the way, depending on the pubs visited you will also hear about some of Liverpool's historic buildings.

Partner Programmes

For those conferences and events where it is traditional for partners to attend, it is often difficult to ensure that they are kept busy during the conference. We can arrange an entertaining, informative and thoroughly enjoyable programme for partners, ensuring that their visit to the city will be an enjoyable one too.

A typical itinerary might look like this:

AM – City Tour including a break for coffee at Liverpool Cathedral

Lunch at one of Liverpool's excellent restaurants

PM – A cruise on the famous Mersey Ferry followed by a visit to Port Sunlight Village and the Lady Lever Art Gallery located on the Wirral Peninsular

Liverpool Themed Evenings

Liverpool is a great place to relax and have some fun. Your delegates have to eat while they are here, so why not combine this with an evening, the type of which you could only have in Liverpool.

Beatles Night – She Loves You, Yeah, Yeah, Yeah

Starting with a three course evening meal at Blake's Restaurant in the Hard Days Night Hotel, the guests are then escorted to the world famous Cavern Club just around the corner for a night of unforgettable Beatles Music.



Singing and dancing will continue into the early hours, but the experience will be remembered for years to come.

As an alternative you can stage the whole evening in the Cavern Club, using their exclusive 'Live Lounge', where hot and cold buffet catering is available.

Football Night – You'll Never Walk Alone

You don't have to be a football fan to know that Liverpool Football Club is one of the most successful clubs in the world.



The evening takes place at Anfield, the home of LFC, where you will have the opportunity to visit the Club Museum, viewing an original European Cup, dine in the Boot Room, the club's highly acclaimed restaurant and then imagine you are on the Kop as you sing along to the famous songs and chants.

Liverpool - a magical, musical city

Mention Liverpool and music in the same sentence and it is probably The Beatles that spring to mind. However, Liverpool was a musical city before The Beatles arrived on the scene.

This entertaining evening includes dinner at one of Liverpool's traditional pubs, followed by a local singer, who will take you through Liverpool's musical history with folk songs, sea shanties, Merseybeat and even some of the more contemporary songs that have made Liverpool, in the opinion of the Guinness book of Records, the pop capital of the world!

Meet and Greet Services

Many conferences and events have participants who may need to be met at Liverpool John Lennon or Manchester Airports, or indeed from Liverpool Lime Street Station.
